What is an endowment fund?

An endowment is a long-term, permanent fund that provides income each year to support the charitable cause, the Paris Center of Fine Arts (PCOFA). Endowment funds are professionally managed to ensure the funds remain strong over time.

Why is an endowment important?

An endowment provides essential stability. It facilitates the strategic use of funds because it allows the PCOFA to plan on the income from one year to the next. The endowment fund also presents an excellent option for donors who want to make legacy or planned gifts.

What is a legacy or planned gift?

Legacy or planned giving describes a variety of giving vehicles that allow donors to support the PCOFA during their lifetime and/or posthumously while meeting their current income needs and providing for their heirs. Planned giving is typically done in conjunction with estate planning, and is a viable option for donors of all income levels. 
